- 6. The event timings are 12:00 to 8:00 PM. Booths must be completely set by 11:00AM.
- 7. Electrical power and Internet access are **not provided**. Vendors are responsible for making their own arrangements with proper prior Nassau County and Town of Oyster Bay permits and approvals.
- 8. Vendors (Food and non-food) are responsible for all permits required for street fairs at their own cost and responsibility from the Department of Health and/or Department of Consumer Affairs, Nassau County. All permits should be obtained at least two (2) days before the event.
- 9. Vendors are responsible for cleaning their booths and disposing garbage at the assigned location. The refundable deposit of \$50.00 will only be refunded upon returning the tables, chairs and the booth area in a clean condition. (NO EXCEPTIONS).
- 10. The organizers do not guarantee a minimum turnout and are not responsible for inadequate turnout.
